Foster Parent Champions bridge relationships between those involved in staffing the child's case plan. We are here to support newly licensed, unlicensed, and experienced caregivers. Our team will reach out to you at the time of placement, and you can always call our hotline to receive additional support at any time.

As a caregiver, Foster Parent Champions are your go-to resource!

New Placement Support

- Educate families and provide referrals to community resources and services
 - WIC, Peggy's Attic, Urban League, support groups, community respite opportunities
- Assist caregivers in understanding and completing documents
- Share parenting tips to manage the changes in your family's dynamics
- Help families build a supportive and caring environment for children in their care
- Strengthen communication and partnerships between caregivers and Family Services staff

Ongoing Support

- Follow up phone calls with caregivers to ensure the family's needs are being met
- Mentor caregivers through unique challenges that only another caregiver would understand
- Suggest appropriate trainings so that caregivers can meet the specific needs of the child
- Offer individualized support and referrals to WRAPS Unit to minimize disruptions
- Coach caregivers and provide tips for smooth transitions
- Provide emotional peer-to-peer support for caregivers

Advocacy

- Relaying the needs of the foster family to the child's caseworker
- Influence policies and make positive changes in the foster care community
- Assist with foster family recruitment
