#### THE IMPACT OF LOSS, GRIEF AND RELATIONAL CONNECTION FOR YOUTH IN FOSTER CARE

365,000

There are over 365,000 children and youth in foster care.

18,500

Approximately 18,500 youth are emancipated from foster care without a permanent family.



In 2021, 77 percent of eligible youth in foster care, ages 14–21 years old, left care without receiving the federally funded services necessary to prepare them for adulthood and independent living.

National Foster Care Month is a movement led by the Children's bureau, that oversees federal regulations and data related to the foster care system. Each year is a different theme to bring attention to one of many complex topics in child welfare. This year, National Foster Care Month (NFCM) will raise awareness about the needs of youth transitioning out of foster care into adulthood and independent living. This year's theme—"Engaging Youth. Building Supports. Strengthening Opportunities."emphasizes how it is essential to create a child welfare system that takes a holistic and culturally responsive approach to engaging youth in planning for their future to help them leave care with lasting relationships, meaningful supports, and greater opportunities.
